







### READY TO ROCK STUDENT TEACHING?

- Overall minimum GPA 2.75
- Secondary students minimum GPA in content area 2.5
- · Pre-requisites and general education courses complete
- · Education courses complete with a minimum grade of "C-"
- Incomplete grade(s) must resolved prior to beginning student teaching
- Forms must be completed and submitted by deadline outlined further in the presentation











## HAWK TALK: STUDENT TEACHING




- Student teaching is a culmination of field experiences after completing coursework with multiple opportunities to observe and engage with students in surrounding school districts
- Transformative experience bridging theory with practice
  - Apply knowledge & skills in an actual classroom
  - · Achieve hands-on experience
  - Develop your professional identity as a teacher for your career
  - · Build relationships with mentors, colleagues, and students
- Transition to assuming full responsibility in the classroom
- Student teaching is a full-time experience
- The course(s) associated with this experience outlines expectations and assignments

## HAWK TALK: ADVANCED TEACHING PRACTICUM

- 40 total hours of advanced teaching practicum for secondary ELA and SS students after completing coursework
- Transition to assuming responsibility in the classroom with a gradual transition out of responsibilities
- 1-2 periods a day for approximately 8 weeks
- Students are assigned the same class(es) of students
- Begins approximately the third week of the fall semester
- The course(s) associated with this experience outlines expectations and assignments



## JOURNEY OF YOUR FINAL YEAR



- Elementary Education program One placement at primary level (K 3rd) & one placement at intermediate level (3<sup>rd</sup> 6<sup>th</sup>); these placements cover experience in the range of grade levels you will be certified to teach
- Elementary Education Unified program fall placement at primary (K-3<sup>rd</sup>) or intermediate (4th-6<sup>th</sup>) & spring placement in elementary special education
- Unified Early Childhood program fall placement at primary level (K-3<sup>rd</sup>) & spring placement in early childhood with special education (Pre-K)
- Secondary program advanced teaching practicum during the fall & student teaching during the spring; 1 placement at the middle level & 1 placement at high school level
- STEM Teach KU program fall or spring semester full time student teaching experience in middle or high school
- Visual Art, Music, and PE program fall or spring semester placement is divided with 1 placement
  at elementary level & one placement at middle or high school level




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### PLACEMENT GOALS

 A variety of experiences with quality Clinical Supervisors prepares you for your career and future success




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
### PLACEMENT PROCESS

As noted on <u>student teaching/advanced</u> teaching practicum preference form you will indicate:

- Indicate preference in grade level range primary (K-3<sup>rd</sup>) or intermediate (4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup>); middle (6-8<sup>th</sup>) or high school (9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>)
- List top three choice from column A and column B
- <u>Click here</u> to reference information about partner districts: All districts are within 50 miles of Lawrence
- All other considerations will be placed in the notes section of the form (i.e., personal or medical concern)

Each school district determines if they have the capacity to support student teachers & assigns Clinical Supervisors











### PLACEMENT REMINDERS

- Reliable transportation is your responsibility and a requirement for student teaching & advanced teaching practicum
- Surrounding school districts are supporting advanced teaching practicum and student teaching for students from KU along with several other universities and therefore, you may not receive your preferred choices
- If you have family employed or attending a school, you will not be placed in that school but can be placed in the same district.
- Due to a conflict of interest, you will not be placed in school(s) you attended
- All arrangements for student teaching and advanced teaching practicum are made through KU Field Experience office.
- Conversations are not permitted with school or district personnel regarding your placement









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## PLACEMENT

- Fall requests are sent to districts the 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> week of March
- Spring requests are sent to districts the 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> week of September
- Districts respond as they work through their process and placement information is sent once the placement is confirmed.
- An email will be sent once your placement is confirmed
- Once you receive confirmation, reach out to your clinical supervisor to introduce yourself and thank them for their valuable assistance.









## LET THE ADVENTURE BEGIN...



- Elementary, EEU, UEC, Secondary, STEM Teach KU, Music, and PE students begin on teacher report date (not the 1st day with students); it is mandatory to experience the beginning of the school year (classroom setup, teacher workdays, professional development sessions, grade level meetings, etc.)
- Art begins before KU classes start
- Follow your placement district calendar regarding breaks;
   additional details will be provided in your course


#### Clinical Supervisor


Educates children/adolescents in your school district; Supports and provides feedback to KU students


Also known as cooperating teacher or mentor

#### University Supervisor

KU School of Education and Human Sciences representative who guides the process (visits and evaluates the student teacher throughout their experience) and acts as a liaison between the Clinical Supervisor and the University.

PDS cohort model is designed to build lasting collaborative relationships with other student teachers as a support structure for the success of their futures


PDS course allows students the opportunity to discuss their experiences & receive ongoing professional development




- Active partnership between the School of Education and Human Sciences & 18 public schools in 5 districts surrounding the main KU campus in Lawrence
  - -Lawrence Public Schools
  - -Shawnee Mission Public Schools
  - -Kansas City Kansas Public Schools
  - -Topeka Public Schools
  - -De Soto School District
  - -Bonner Springs School District
  - -Coming Soon Rural District

Program is designed to offer teacher candidates numerous enriching opportunities in schools that are dedicated to overcoming academic, language, & socio-economic challenges

#### **PDS**


- Cohort model More than 1 student in the building
- Partnership focuses on teacher prep, professional development, research, and student learning. Schools are committed to KU PDS program
- Year long placement at the same school with same University Supervisor
- Coursework is reflective of PDS goals
- Students involved in classroom & school-wide teaching, professional development, inquiry, PLC, and committees
- Fall observations of spring placement classroom
- Classroom observations develop a larger repertoire of instructional, differentiation, assessment, & management strategies
- Flexible Friday workshops


#### Both

- Clinical Supervisors meet KU requirements
- Observe the beginning and ending of the school year
- Kick-off session in April/May
- Apply knowledge & skills in an actual classroom
- Build relationships with mentors, colleagues, and students
- Develop your professional identity as a teacher for your career

- University Supervisor might change


















## HAWK TALK: PROFESSIONAL IMAGE

## HEALTH ASSESSMENT & TUBERCULOSIS TEST


#### Heath Assessment


-Healthcare provider assesses overall health stating they found no evidence of any physical condition with the health, safety, or welfare of the pupil that would prevent the individual from working in a safe and healthful manner.


#### Tuberculosis (TB) Test

-Once administered you will return to the facility in 48 hours for the results to be determined

- Ensure both parts of the form are signed and dated by healthcare provider
- If you have a health assessment and/or TB test, check the date to ensure it is not older than one year from the day you will begin the experience
- You may utilize Watkins Health Center, physician's office, & some pharmacies










## VALIDITY BACKGROUND CHECK

- Background checks are a vital step in the process to ensure that those working with children have clean records and can be trusted to provide a safe, effective learning environment.
- Validity Screening Solutions provides the detailed information required by our partner districts
- · Click here to review instructions; \$36 fee
- Results will be emailed to The School of Education & Human Sciences within 2-4 weeks via a secure web interface
- You will be notified of results when available access through the Validity website
- · A copy of your background check will be sent to the district
- Kansas State Department of Education and districts are concerned about crimes related to drugs, theft, or children
- If you have concerns about a prior diversion or conviction, please reach out ASAP









## PROFESSIONAL LIABILITY COVERAGE

- Liability coverage protects educators from paying for legal fees or judgements against them if a parent or student takes legal action against you; Even if you hold yourself to high standards, mistakes happen, and parents can initiate lawsuits that would cause you to incur legal costs
- Student teachers are required by the University of Kansas to carry \$1,000,000 in liability coverage
- Coverage can be purchased from insurance providers or National Educators Association
- Proof of coverage of million dollars along with coverage dates must be included in document submitted
- Most students join NEA (KNEA) student program since the coverage is one of the many benefits of student membership
- \$18 for the academic year (\$15 for membership and \$3 for KU Chapter dues)
- <u>Sign up online</u> AFTER April 1st (signing up prior to April 1st, enrolls you for the current academic year & will need to be renewed again before fall experience)
  - \$1 million in liability coverage is required for placement







## BLOODBORNE PATHOGEN TRAINING

- Bloodborne pathogen training certifies that employes have been educated on how to protect themselves against exposure
- Training is provided via Canvas through the KU Department of Environment, Health, and Safety at no cost
- Complete steps 1-7 under KU EHS Blackboard Course Self Enrollment Instructions - Course # EHS000-001
